Breakfast Burritos

Ingredients:

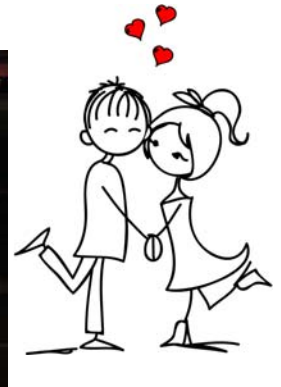
- ♥ 2 packages Tortillas
- ♥ Dash of Milk
- ♥ Dozen Eggs
- ♥ Package of Cheese (Mozzarella or Cheddar)
- ♥ Salt & Pepper
- ♥ Vegetables of your Choice (Mushrooms, Peppers, Onions, Broccoli)



Directions:

1. Chop all Vegetables.
2. Get a big bowl, scramble all eggs in the bowl. Add a dash of milk, salt, pepper, cheese and vegetables. Stir until combined.
3. Proceed to cook the eggs in a pan on the stove.
4. Lay out Tortillas. Once eggs are cooked, place equal amounts on tortillas. Roll tortillas and place in baking dish. Sprinkle any extra cheese on top.
5. Heat oven to 350. Put tortillas in the oven and cook for 10 to 15 minutes or until golden brown.

The infants explored musical instruments this week. We played the drums, maraca, and bells. We read some new books together and walked across sticky contact paper.

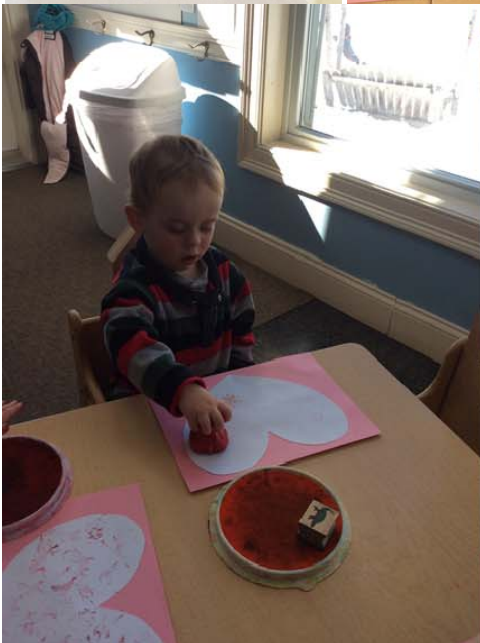
The older infants have been visiting the toddler classroom.
