We have done so many fun activities this week! We gave the guinea pigs baths, used the gems on the light table, did marble painting, made and used fake snow, and played with dress up!

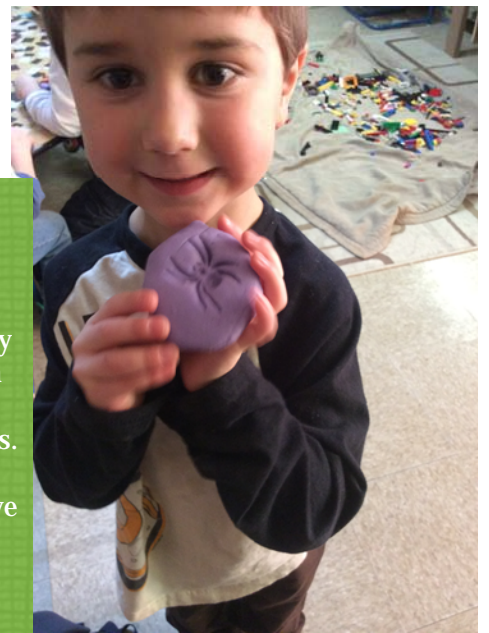
