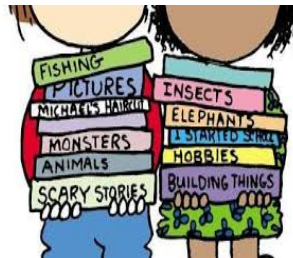

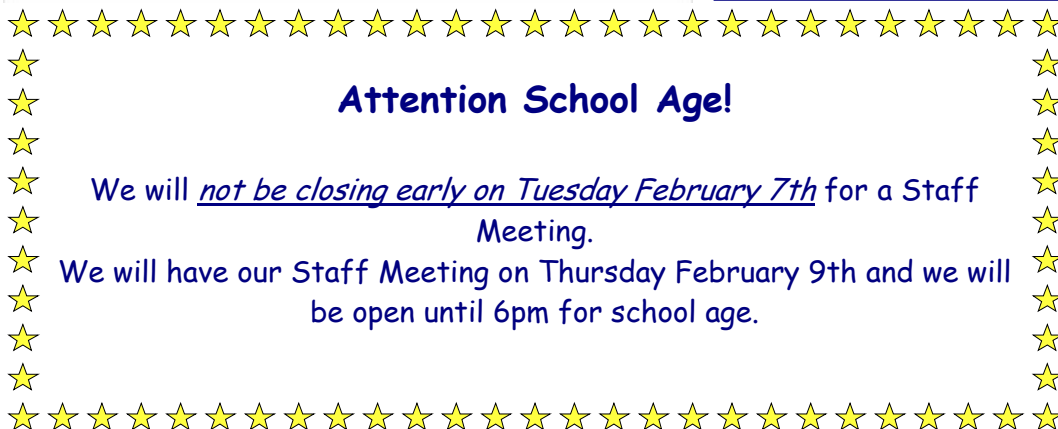

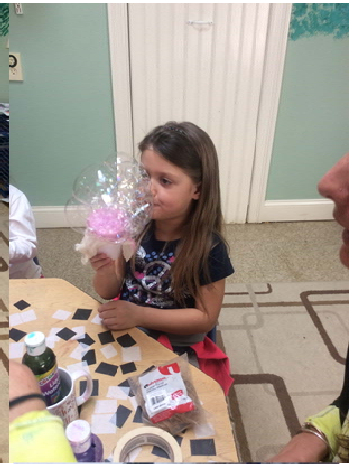


Older Preschool

We were very busy this week! We had so much fun doing art activities, searching for animals tracks in the snow, exploring magnets, and going on the pizza field trip!

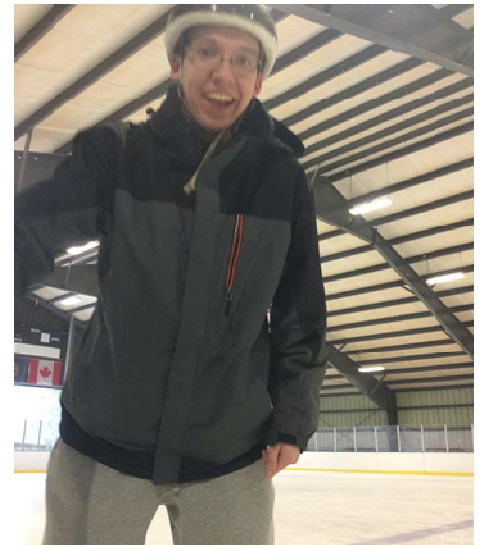

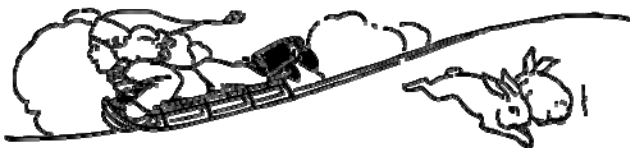
